<u>Activity</u>: Students will receive a calendar where they will be able to keep track of the amount of time they spend being active. Each grade level will have a goal that they can choose to complete (ex. 6th grade - 1,000 min/month). Login into Canvas to get your Zoom Meeting ID

Steps to login:

- 1. Students will need to login into our LMS (Learning Management System) Canvas to get started. (https://troysd.instructure.com/login/canvas)
- 2. Use your school id and password. Example: 3rd grade ID would be 29jsmith and password js1234. (Remember it is the year you graduate first initial last name for your ID, then first initial first name and first initial last name and the last 4 numbers of your lunch number).
- 3. Once you are logged in select your course and then go to the link. "Computer Class Links" for a list of different activities. (Ex. TIS Typing Club, EverFi for 5th and 6th grade, Learn your States and Capitals, Digital Passport, GCFLearnFree and Khan Academy and more) or select the link "Learn to Code" select your id and picture password and pick up from what you have done in class

All updates will be done in our LMS Canvas course.
